12 This begins tape number two. The time is 11:10 a.m. 11:10:25
13 Q. (By Mr. Burns) Mr. Glick, we'll continue. 11:10:30
14 You good to go? 11:10:33
15 A. Yes. 11:10:34
16 Q. Okay. We have a recording that Mr. Evans is 11:10:35
17 going to play and I want to ask you about. It's 11:10:41
18 actually a recording, I think, off of Facebook of 11:10:45
19 Ms. Amacher, I want to ask you a few questions about. 11:10:48
20 A. Okay. 11:10:52
21 THE COURT REPORTER: Do you want me to write 11:10:52
22 this as well? 11:10:52
23 MR. BURNETTE: Yeah. It's not too long. 11:10:52
24 (Recording played as follows: "And since 11:10:52
25 executive sessions are fair game -- just going to be 11:10:52

1 honest -- I have a recording of one. You all don't want 11:11:15
2 me to release that. But please, please have it 11:11:19
3 subpoenaed, including this one that I was called into. 11:11:22
4 Okay? And I can" --) 11:11:25
5 (Recording ended.) 11:11:27
6 Q. (By Mr. Burns) Were you able to hear and see 11:11:30
7 that? 11:11:32
8 A. I heard it. I didn't see it. 11:11:32
9 Q. Okay. There -- there is video of it. But 11:11:34
10 does that sound like Ms. Amacher's -- 11:11:41
11 A. Yeah. 11:11:42
12 Q. -- voice to you? That's her -- 11:11:43
13 A. Yeah. That sounds like her, yeah. 11:11:45
14 Q. And did you hear her say something about 11:11:46
15 having a recording of an executive session? 11:11:49
16 A. I did hear that, yeah. 11:11:51
17 Q. Do you know what she's referring to? 11:11:53
18 A. I think she's referring to, from what I've 11:11:55
19 heard, is the -- because I've heard her speak of an 11:11:57
20 executive session before that was done -- what do you 11:12:00
21 call it? About my case. 11:12:06
22 Q. About this litigation? 11:12:08
23 A. Yes. 11:12:11
24 Q. Okay. I'm going to represent to you that that 11:12:12
25 was taken off of Facebook Live off of her Facebook 11:12:17

1 account on April -- it wasn't taken off; it was recorded 11:12:21
2 on April 26, 2022. Okay? 11:12:26
3 A. Okay. 11:12:29
4 Q. That was before you were on the board. 11:12:30
5 Correct? 11:12:32
6 A. Yeah. It would have been, yeah. 11:12:34
7 Q. Yeah. Do you know why she was talking about 11:12:35
8 recording an executive session? 11:12:38
9 MR. BURNETTE: Object to the form. 11:12:40
10 A. No, I don't. 11:12:42
11 Q. (By Mr. Burns) Okay. Has she told you why 11:12:42
12 she got on Facebook and was talking about recording an 11:12:45
13 executive session? 11:12:49
14 A. No. And I don't -- I had a Face- -- I got a 11:12:50
15 Facebook page for my campaign and put some stuff on 11:12:54
16 there, but I do not get on Facebook. 11:12:58
17 Q. Okay. And prior to the time that ran, 11:13:00
18 Mr. Glick, is it correct that you were not on any form 11:13:03
19 of social media? 11:13:07
20 A. No, I wasn't. 11:13:07
21 Q. Okay. 11:13:09
22 A. I think I had a Facebook page created at one 11:13:09
23 time, but -- 11:13:13
24 Q. Never used it? 11:13:13
25 A. -- I never -- I never -- yeah. 11:13:14

1 Q. Okay. 11:13:15

2 A. It's a waste of time. 11:13:15

3 Q. Before hearing Ms. Amacher today, were you 11:13:17

4 aware of the existence of this recording she's talking 11:13:20

5 about? 11:13:24

6 A. I was aware of the executive session. 11:13:24

7 Q. Okay. And how were you aware of the executive 11:13:26

8 session? 11:13:30

9 A. Ms. Amacher told me. 11:13:30

10 Q. And what did she tell you about it? 11:13:31

11 A. Just told me that they had an executive 11:13:36

12 session discussing my case. 11:13:39

13 Q. Okay. And she didn't tell you anything about 11:13:40

14 the specifics or the substance? 11:13:43

15 A. No. She said -- no, she didn't. She said 11:13:45

16 they just went over my case with attorneys. And she 11:13:47

17 said that she thought the executive session was 11:13:52

18 improper, that it was a violation of what an executive 11:13:55

19 session should be or whatever. I mean, I -- I don't 11:14:00

20 know if I stated that right, but that's -- 11:14:04

21 Q. Okay. Well, what were the circumstances or in 11:14:07

22 what context was it that this conversation came about or 11:14:11

23 started between you and her? 11:14:14

24 A. She was upset about my termination. 11:14:16

25 Q. Okay. And so she's in favor of you filing 11:14:19

1 suit against the City? 11:14:23

2 MR. BURNETTE: Object to the form. 11:14:26

3 A. Yeah. I couldn't -- 11:14:27

4 Q. (By Mr. Burns) Has she expressed to you that 11:14:28

5 she's in favor of you filing suit against the City? 11:14:30

6 A. Not in so many words. 11:14:34

7 Q. Okay. And to be sure you weren't terminated, 11:14:36

8 you retired. Right? 11:14:38

9 A. Sort of, yeah. 11:14:40

10 Q. Yeah. Well, we've established there is no 11:14:41

11 termination paperwork or notice. Right? 11:14:45

12 A. No. 11:14:47

13 Q. Okay. 11:14:48

14 A. No, there's not. 11:14:48

15 Q. But she's characterized it as a termination to 11:14:49

16 you? 11:14:52

17 A. I don't recall if she used those terms. 11:14:57

18 Q. Okay. Well, where were you when you had this 11:14:58

19 conversation with her about this executive session? 11:15:02

20 A. I don't recall. It was probably when I was 11:15:06

21 still employed with the City. I mean way back. 11:15:09

22 Q. Well, if this occurred in April of 2022, you 11:15:11

23 weren't with the City then? 11:15:14

24 A. That was when she said on Facebook. 11:15:15

25 Q. Yeah. You filed the lawsuit on January 13th 11:15:21
